Training/Exposure Visits:

DMU Head: Mokokchung, Shri. Ao Chuba IFS attended the "Knowledge Co Creation Programme on sustainable Forest management and Integrated Watershed Management under counterpart training program" held at Japan from 19th August 2019 to September 6th 2019.



The 21 days module was packed with different activities with hands on experience on Management of Forest Park to Private Forests and Prefecture Forests to National Forests. Forests Management is being done for environmental protection, protection from natural disasters (typhoon, frost etc) and protection of agricultural lands by undertaking massive windbreak plantations. Good quality seedlings for plantations (high yielding species, pest and disease resistant plants) were produced through plant breeding techniques at High-Tech nursery managed by private corporations. Japan has successfully implemented a high-tech Soil & Moisture Conservation for control of erosion. The Foundations for Forest & Nature Conservation are actively involved in forest conservation & beautification.

In Japan, large scale production of Shitake Mushroom provide alternative livelihood to the rural poor, which can also be adopted in our state. The forest based waste management is another interesting practice, where leaves, twigs, branches and other wastes were used to produce electricity and wooden fuel pellets. Visit to Japan was exhilarating with a bundle of novel experiences. It's undoubtedly true as the saying goes 'Japan has something to take home for everyone who visits'.

Inspection at Tuophema Village and Nsunyu Village

An inspection of the nurseries set up at Tuophema village under Kohima was carried out on 20th August 2019. JICA Project Advisor Shri A.K Bansal, Chief Project Director Shri. Dhramenrda Pakash IFS, Shri Suvil Ltu ACF, Smt. Rongsenlemla IFS, DFO, DMU head, DMU Support, FMU head and his staff visited the nurseries. The nurseries has thousands of saplings like Khokon (Daubanga), Mandhani (Acrocarpus fraxini folius), Rain tree (Albizia saman), koroi (Albizia species). JFMC Chairman Mr. Dzieselhou Thong presented a brief demonstration of khokon germination process. Mr. Sasievi Kaco, JFMC vice chairman expressed his gratitude to the officials for their visit and informed that the saplings in the nurseries will be planted in those areas where there are less trees. After inspection and deliberation with the village members, the visiting officials encouraged the village members to continue the good work that is being carried out. Similarly a field visit cum inspection to Nsunyu village was carried out on 11/12/19 comprising of Project Advisor A.K. Bansal. PMC Dept. Officials, PMU & DMU Staff.
