Activities at a glance (January '19 - March '19:

- 1. All DMUs have conducted the interview for recruitment of support staff for DMU and FMU on the 5th of February 2019.
- 2. Opening of Financial bids of Firms for **Project Management Consultancy** selection was done from Thursday,i.e 14.02.2019 as notified earlier.
- 3. Micro-plan preparation training for DMU heads and FMU heads was held on the 5th and 6th March 2019 at Kohima.
- 4. RFP for NGOs was finalized during this quarter.
- 5. PMU had a consultative meeting with the Nagaland Bamboo mission on the 16th of March 2019 as part of its preliminary study for bamboo scooping.
- **6.** Laptops for DMUs and PMU was purchased and distributed during the quarter.
- 7. The Annual Work plan & Financial Outlay FY 2019-20 was finalized during the quarter.
- 8. Three Reimbursement Claims have been approved and disbursed by JICA amounting to INR 4,06,69,501 (Rupees four crores six lakhs sixty nine thousand five hundred and one) only. The fourth Reimbursement Claim INR 3,45,88,202 has been recently submitted to JICA
- 9. Out of the targeted 75 buildings for construction under the project, constructions of 55 buildings have commenced. Few of the buildings are completed while construction of some of the remaining buildings have not commenced due to land issues.




INTERVIEW AT THE DMU LEVEL FOR RECRUITMENT OF SUPPORT STAFF FOR DMU AND FMU



As a part of the Bamboo Scooping Study as envisaged in the work plan for the project, a consultative meeting as well as a brief exposure visit to study the activities of the Nagaland Bamboo Development Agency was undertaken at the Bamboo Resource Centre, Dimapur Nagaland. A four member team of the PMU, viz, Mr. Meyipokyim PD, Mr.Supongnukshi PD, Ms.Kim Thoutang DyPD & Mr. Ango Konyak DyPD visited the centre on the 16th of March 2019. This study aims to come up with a detailed analysis on the resource status and prospects on the value additions and market linkages on bamboos for the state.
